Action Agenda

- 1. The ESC approved the Action Agenda 2011-2013 with the following revisions:
 - a. In the Waters and Watersheds section an accomplishment will be added to describe the water quality monitoring of Long Island Sound.
 - b. The introduction will note the LISS Management Committee approval of the Action Agenda for ESC consideration and the ESC approval.
 - c. The ESC approved the following statement endorsing the Action Agenda.
 - i. "Consistent with the Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan, the Executive Steering Committee of the Long Island Sound Study endorses the Long Island Sound Study Action Agenda: 2011-2013 as a path forward to guide priority actions to improve water quality, restore habitat, conserve the land, maintain biodiversity, and increase opportunities for human use and enjoyment of the Sound."
