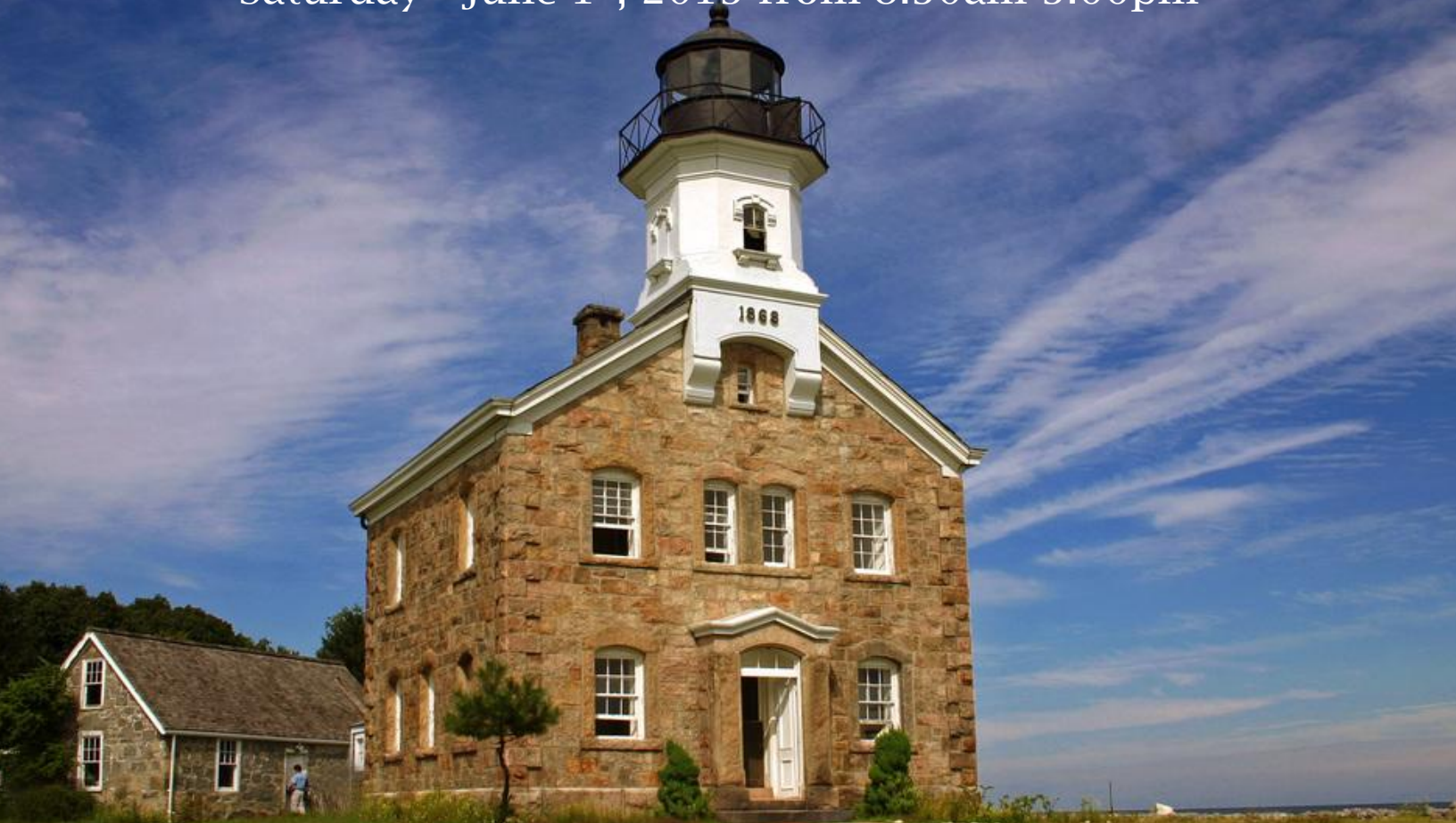


COME CELEBRATE NATIONAL TRAILS DAY ON SHEFFIELD ISLAND!

Help clean up damage from Super Storm Sandy, pull invasive plants, and maintain a nature trail.

Take a FREE ferry ride to Sheffield Island and help Stewart B. McKinney National Wildlife Refuge, the Long Island Sound Study, and the Norwalk Seaport Association pull invasive plants, maintain the nature trail, and clean up storm damage. In return for your help, we will provide everyone with a tour of the historic lighthouse, a guided nature walk, tour of the Norwalk harbor, and time to enjoy the natural island environment through exploration. Spend the day on the island - bring a picnic lunch and dine on the grass with a view of the Long Island Sound. Open to adults and children (9 and older; children must be accompanied by an adult).
